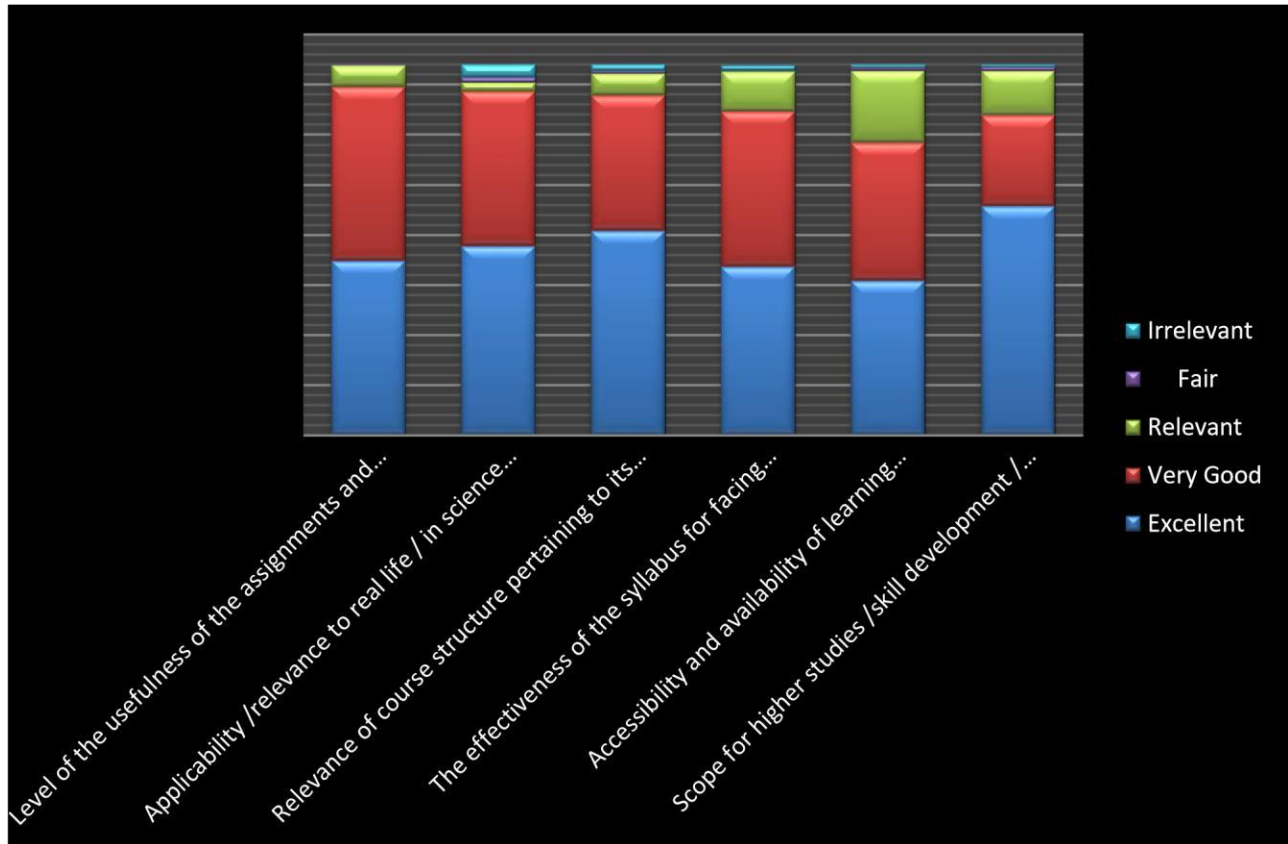


### Students' Feedback on Curriculum
