Eligibility criteria for undergraduate courses:

- The applicant must be a India. The applicant should have passed the class XII examination of any board recognized as equivalent to the 10+2 system.
- The applicant should have "passed" individually in each subject required (including particles if any) for calculating merit and eligibility to the course they seek admission. Applicants with "compartment" results are eligible to apply.
- Applicants with gap year(s) will not be at any disadvantage to the purpose of admission to under graduate courses.
- Applicants under the UR/SC/ST/OBC/EWS categories are eligible to seek admission based on both merit and entrance tests to courses in all colleges.

Admission process:

- ❖ Applicants seeking admission in the college to the (UG) merit-based programmers /Courses and TGUGCET entrance test must register online through the UG admission web portal,
- ❖ https://ttwries.in(for details see bulletin of information). The process after registration for merit-based admissions is as follows:

- ❖ Through dost we need to create the Dost id by using the inter hall ticket Number this is called the pre-registration before the registration need to link up the phone number with Aadhar card.
- ❖ After getting the ID we need to upload all the documents through online and we need to pay dost amount fee.
- ❖ By using the ID, we have to choose the course option, and also enter the Ph.no which is registered with Andhra link after it generates the OTP, we need to enter OTP and submit.
- ❖ We are having the 5 courses up to 2021.we introduced the new courses which is called bucket system like MSCs, MSDs, BCCs, ZCCs, E.P.CA, H.E.CA on 2022, again we brought new course on 2023 i.e., B.Com(Genral).
- ❖ Once the admission is cancelled the applicant cannot seek readmission in the event that they don't secure admission in a different courses/college.

- ❖ After completion of online process from the college we are providing SPOT admission for this admission need to bring all originals, 2-xerox sets,200/-
- ❖ All the category of the students can take the admission by passing 10+2 level but most of the priority gives the Tribe students.
- ❖ SC, BC students have less seats comparing to ST students. If the belongs to SC/ST/BC, the first priority gives for St Students.
- ➤ The applicant who meets the requisite cut off should select the college/program where they wish to take admission after logging into dost admission portal using their registration account
- The applicant must reach the college with print out off the form along with the required original documents, with 8 photo copies, physical fitness, any sports certificate,2-xerox set copies and 3-resent passport size photograph
- ➤ The applicant will present the document in the college and produce the originals for offline verification after which the college will approve the admission. Admitted provisional students will have to produce the originals of the required mandatory documents to the college with in a week.

Requirements for admission:

1. Qualifying Examinations:

- For the purpose of admission to the I-Year of under graduate shall be senior secondary school certificate examination (class-XII) of the state board of secondary education/An examination recognized as equivalent there to.
- The applicant seeking admission to the UG courses offered by the university should have passed the qualifying the examination obtaining minimum marks as specified for each of the courses in sub-sequent sections.

2. Age requirement:

• As per ordinance of the university there is no minimum age bar per admission to the under courses in the university and its colleges.

3. Gap years will not be a bar for purposes of admission to the undergraduate course.

• The applications for admission to the UG courses in the college in respect to applicants belonging to the examining bodies of boards/university recognized/UGC/Ministry of Human Resource development shall be considered by the college.



- On the occasion of celebrating women's day our students participated in Jute bags making guidance session. The purpose of the program is awareness among people about women empowerment and environmental conversation.




