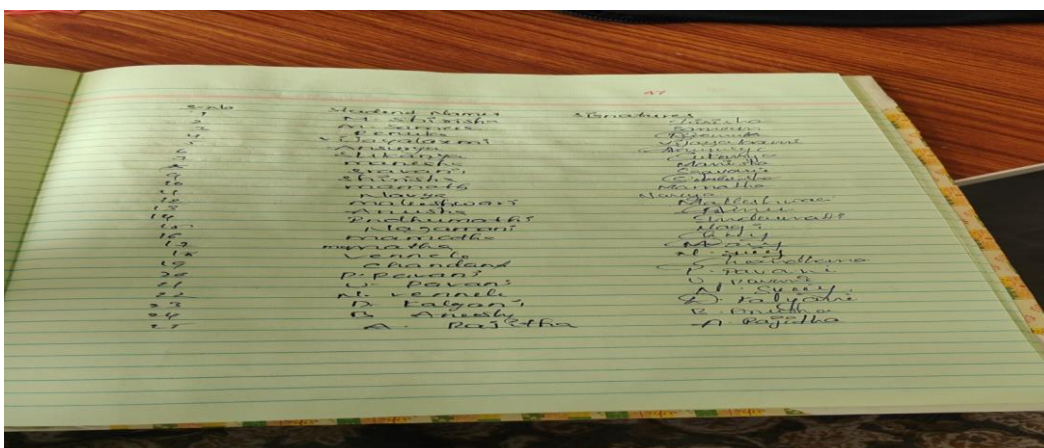
About International Women's Day
