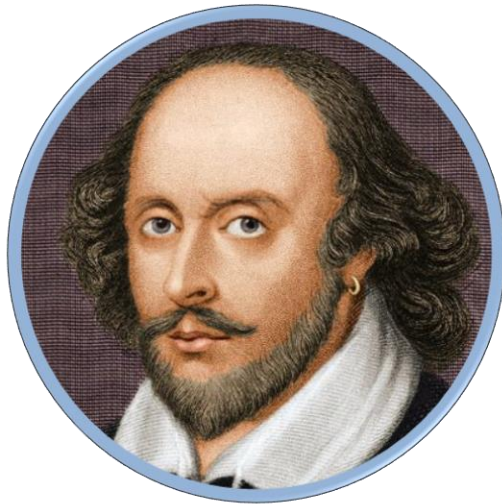

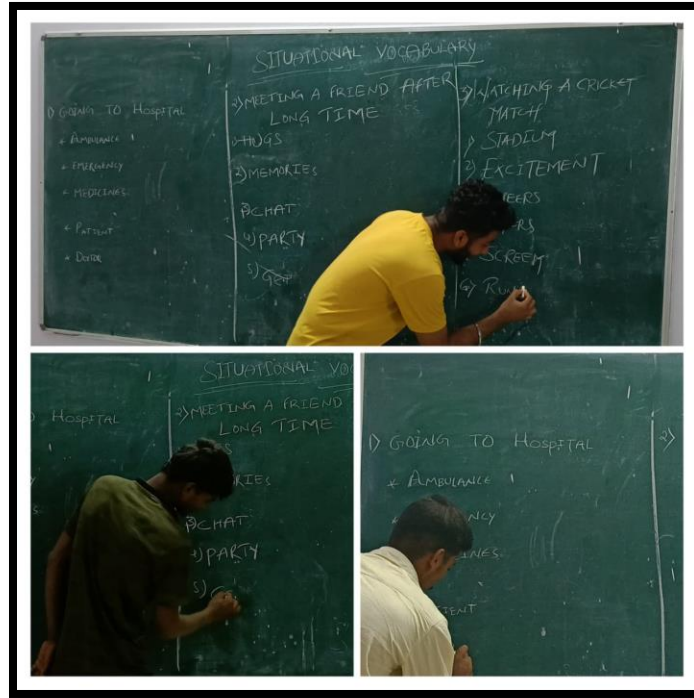
DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH ACTIVITIES

SITUATIONAL VOCABULARY

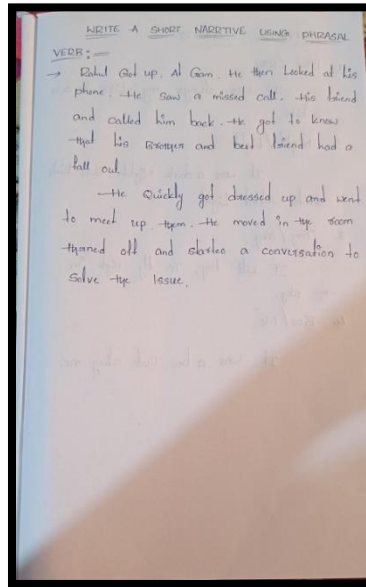


- Under this activity students were given situations and were asked to develop vocabulary related to the situation

CV WRITING

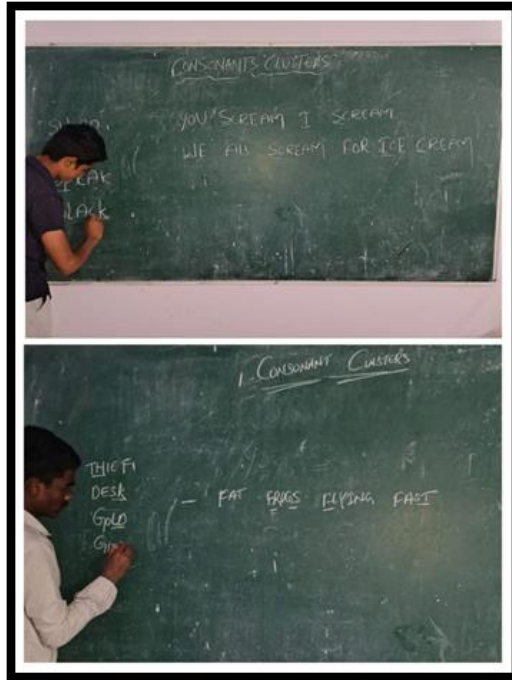
- Under this activity students were asked to prepare CV

WRITE A SHORT NARRATIVE USING PHRASAL VERBS



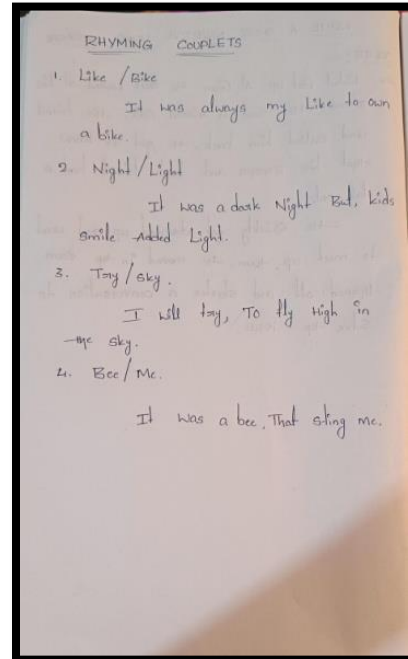
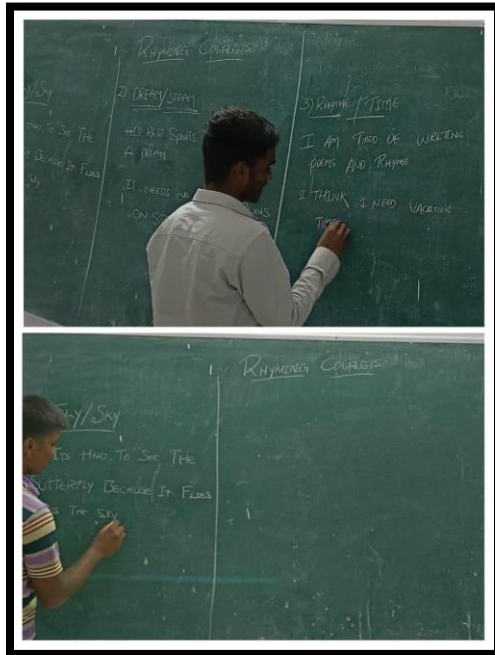
- Under this activity students were asked to write a narrative using phrasal verbs.

- This activity also helped them to make use of their imagination in creating consonant clusters in the form of tongue twisters

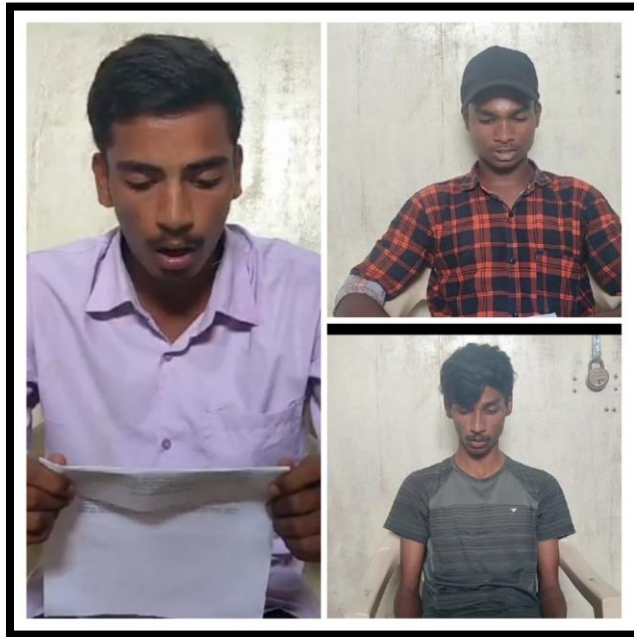
BUILDING RHYMING COUPLETS

- Many students participated but the best were L. Naresh , R. Mitranand , Manideep from BCom II and E.Akshay of BZC II

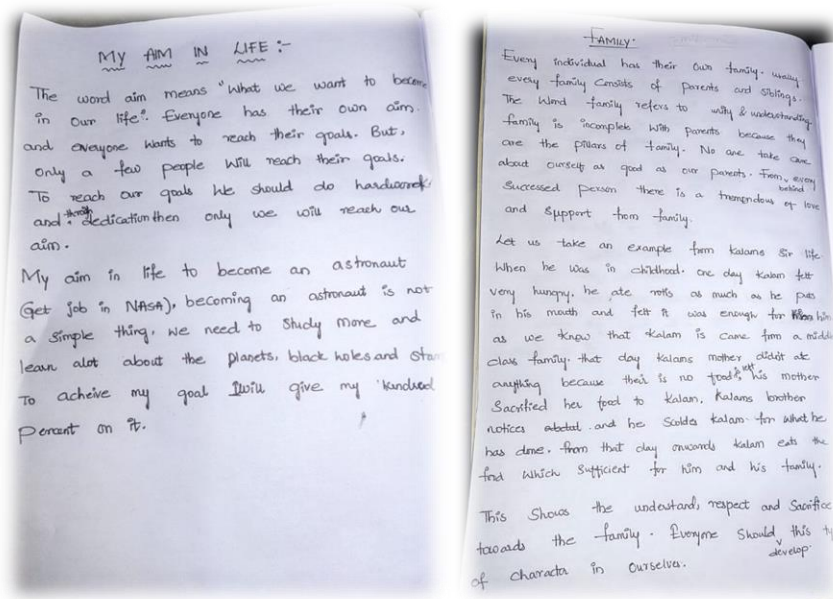
ROLE PLAY

- This activity helped them develop their interpersonal skills

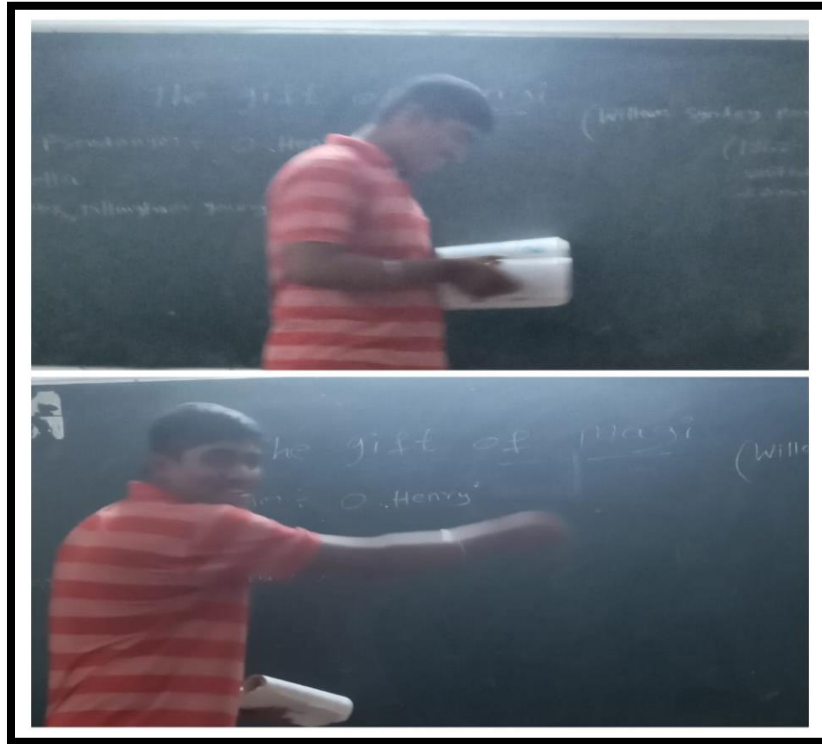

FAVOURITE LITERARY CHARACTER



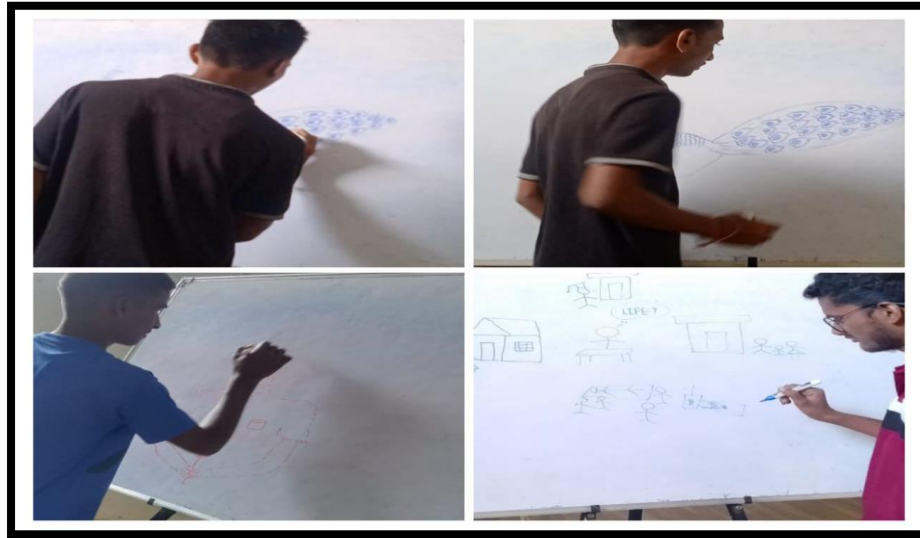
- Students were asked to draw their favourite literary character and were asked to talk about it.

ESSAY WRITING



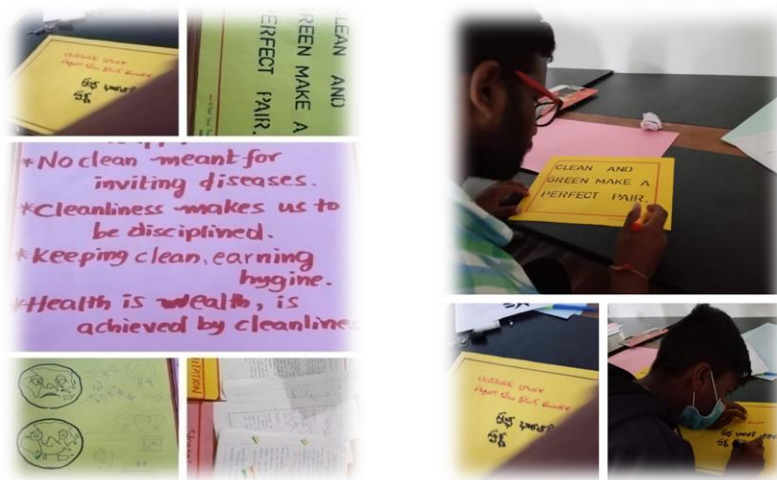
- An essay is an important tool for expressing our ideas, opinions and arguments. It is also a great way to demonstrate our knowledge and understanding of a given topic.

- Many students participated and the best were awarded. The winners were Nanda kumar of BZC III and Devi Vara Prasad of Mpcs III

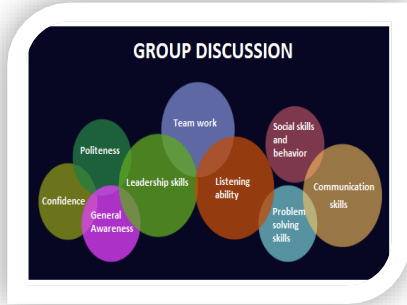

Why use role-play?

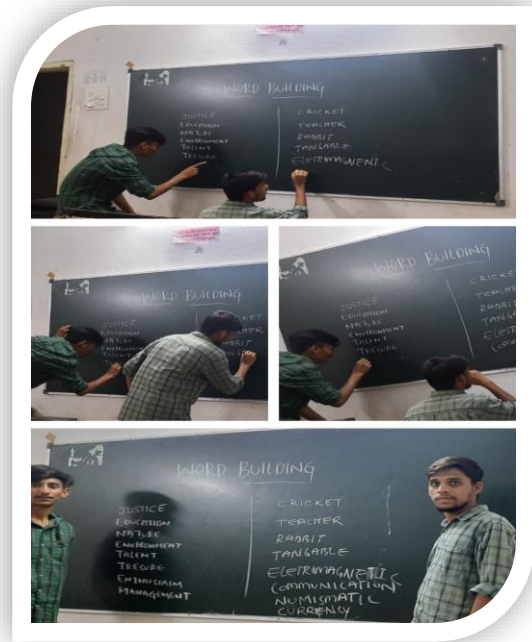
- It is widely agreed that learning takes place when activities are engaging and memorable. Jeremy Harmer advocates the use of role-play for the following reasons:
- It's fun and motivating
- Quieter students get the chance to express themselves in a more forthright way
- The world of the classroom is broadened to include the outside world - thus offering a much wider range of language opportunities
- Students participated actively and exhibited their skills profoundly.

JUST A MINUTE



- The activity 'Just a minute or JAM' is an impromptu speech where the speaker is supposed to express the idea (s) on the given topic, within the duration of a minute. It is quite common to see a speaker experiencing nervousness when asked to speak instantly. Effective impromptu speaking is a skill that can be learnt through practice and training. - Students are divided into groups where one member from a group will come pick up a chit where words are written and act what's written. The other group will recognize and speak on it.

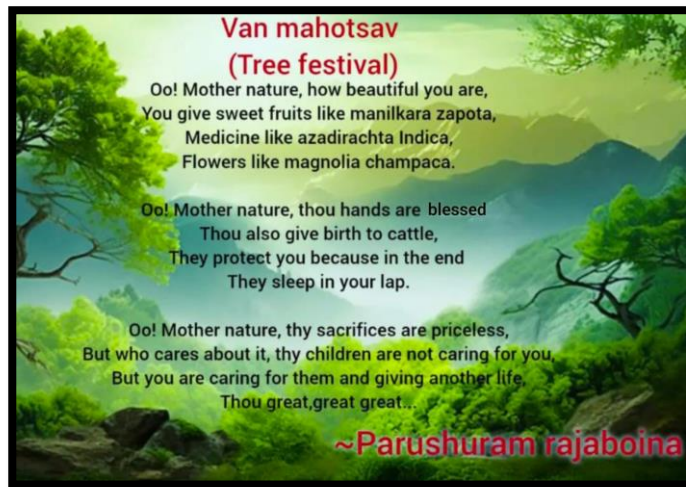
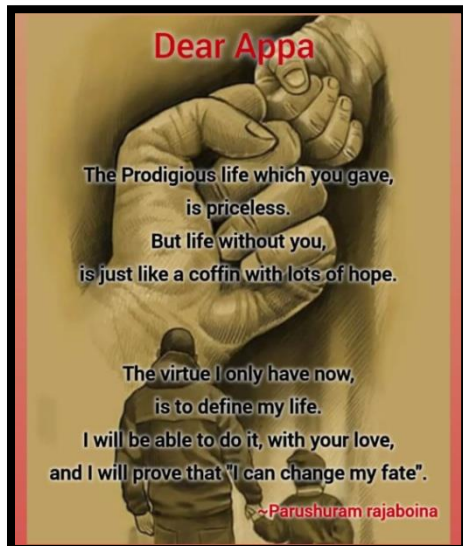
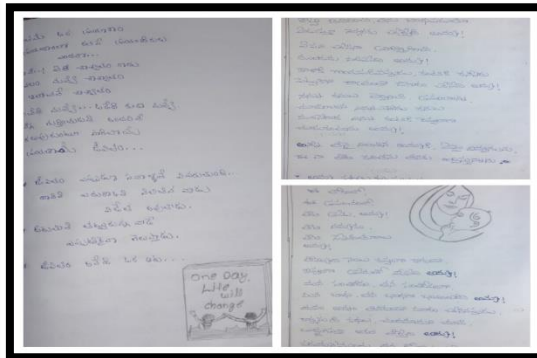
