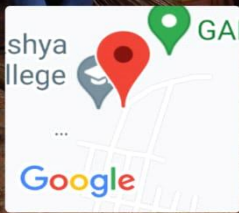

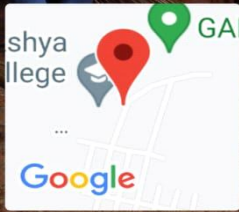

Third day, all the sanitation workers have taken very good initiative in cleaning the washrooms and toilets, tanks, terrace. Rat holes were also identified and cemented.





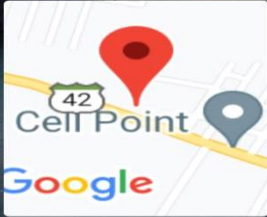

DAY 4 : CLEANING KITCHEN AND DINING AREA

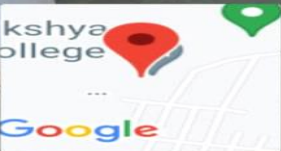

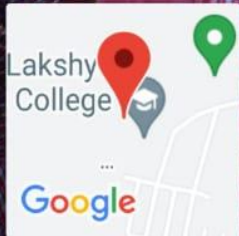

HARITHA HARAM:

Telangana Ku Haritha Haram or **Haritha Haram** is a large-scale tree-planting program implemented by the Government of Telangana to increase the amount of tree cover in the state from 24% to 33%.

The program was launched by Telangana Chief Minister Kalvakuntla Chandrashekar Rao on 3 July 2015. It is one of the Telangana Flagship programmes to rejuvenate degraded forests, protecting these forests from threats such as smuggling, encroachment, fire and grazing. It adopted intensive soil and moisture conservation measures based on a watershed approach.

In the areas outside the existing forest, massive planting activities were to be taken up in areas such as; road-side avenues, river and canal banks, barren hills and foreshore areas, institutional premises, religious places, housing colonies, community lands, municipalities and industrial parks. The National Forest Policy of India envisages a minimum of 33% of the total geographical area under forest cover to maintain environmental stability and ecological balance, which is vital for the sustenance of all life-forms, be it human, animal.

Specific duties and responsibilities are assigned to different committees to ensure the implementation of the programme in a well designed way. These committees do regular field inspections and monitor the ongoing plantation and nursery works. The committees are the State Level Steering Committee and the District Level Monitoring and Co-ordination Committee.

Sub:- TTWREIS (Gurukulam), Hyderabad - Telanganaku Haritha Haram 2021-22 - Instructions issued to all the Regional Coordinators, Principals of TTWRs/RJC/URJC/RDCs and HMs of Mini Gurukulams to take up plantations in all the TTWRE Institutions - Reg.

Ref:- Circular Memo No.3270/AR&T/2015, Dated:05.03.2015 of GAD, Govt. of TS.

"Telanganaku Haritha Haaram (THH)", is a flagship programme of the State Government which envisages increasing the tree cover of the State to 33% of the total geographical area. The strategy developed to achieve the above objective is undertaking massive plantation programme in every possible open space outside the forest and take up intensive rejuvenation and regeneration works coupled with soil and moisture conservation in the degraded forest areas throughout the State.

As part of THH, plantations have been taken up in all the premises of all TTWRE Institutions, i.e., Schools, Colleges and Mini Gurukulams in the previous years as per the targets communicated. This year also targets are being allotted to each of the RCs/Principals to take up plantations in all the TTWRE Institutions as shown in the annexure enclosed.

All the Regional Coordinators/Principals are informed to take up plantations in all the TTWRE Institutions (Schools, Colleges and Mini Gurukulams). The services of the RCs/Principals and the staff who are on watch and ward duties in the institution should be used for taking up the Telanganaku Haritha Haram Program. 01-07-2021 has been fixed as the plantation day in TW Institutions and on that day the total target given to the TTWRE Institutions i.e 12,199 (Tweleve thousand one hundred and ninty nine) have to be planted in the TTWRE Institutions (Schools, Colleges and Mini Gurukulams).

Further it has been noticed that some Principals are not taking up plantation in entire campus and taking up the plantation in pieces. Thus all the RCs/Principal's should see that plantation is done in the entire empty space of the Institution campus this year.

The plants required can be obtained from the GP Nursery or concerned MPDO or DRDO who is the nodal officer of the Dist. for "Haritha Haram" can be consulted. The entire program has to be taken up in consultation with the concerned District Collector. Weekly progress report can be emailed to asplanningttwreis@gmail.com email ID without fail.
