

NATIONAL VOTERS DAY- JANUARY 25

National Voters' Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm at Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential College (G), Kothagudem. The program commenced with the Principal hoisting the flag, followed by the administration of the National Voters' Day pledge to students and staff.

A rally was organised where students carried placards with slogans promoting voter participation. The Electoral Literacy Committee set up a special registration desk to enroll previously unregistered eligible students as voters, providing assistance with Form-6 and documentation.

The Electoral Literacy Committee conducted an awareness session on EVM/VVPAT usage. The event concluded with emphasising the importance of informed and active electoral participation among young voters.

VOTER LITERACY SURVEY AT GOUTHAM NAGAR COLONY, KOTHAGUDEM- 08/09/2023

A comprehensive Voter Literacy Survey was conducted at Goutham Nagar Colony, Kothagudem, by the Electoral Literacy Committee of Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential College (G). Students gained practical experience in conducting door-to-door surveys while raising voter awareness among residents.

The survey focused on:

- Identifying unregistered eligible voters
- Educating residents about the voter registration process
- Providing information about required documentation
- Explaining the importance of electoral participation

Students were divided into teams and equipped with survey forms to collect data about:

- Voter ID status
- Reasons for non-registration
- Awareness about voting rights
- Knowledge of the registration process

The initiative served dual purposes - providing students with hands-on experience in conducting surveys while identifying and assisting unregistered voters in the colony. The data collected will help in organizing targeted voter registration drives and awareness programs in the future.













STUDENT COUNCIL ELECTIONS

The Student Council Elections at Gurukulam represent a significant annual tradition that embodies democratic values and leadership development among students. Following the institution's established protocols, elections were successfully conducted on September 19, 2023 and 2024, initiating with a formal notification for nominations from eligible second-year students. The electoral process was meticulously organized with a structured administrative team, including a Presiding Officer, Polling Officer, Assistant Polling Officer, and Counting Officer, ensuring a transparent and fair election process.

The election encompassed various crucial leadership positions including Captain, Vice-Captain, General Secretary, and several portfolio leaders responsible for sports Captains Sports Secretary, Hygiene Captain Hygiene Secretary, food Captain & food Secretary, student welfare, cultural activities, and academic affairs. Students participated enthusiastically in the democratic process, casting their votes through a formal ballot system under strict supervision, demonstrating their understanding of civic responsibility and democratic participation.

Following the polling process, the counting of votes was conducted with utmost precision by designated counting officers in the presence of witnesses, maintaining the integrity of the electoral process. The results were promptly declared, identifying the successful candidates who would form the new Student Council. The culmination of the election process was marked by a formal oath-taking ceremony on September 21, 2023, where the Principal officially inducted the newly elected leaders into their respective positions.
