HUMAN RIGHTS DAY

DECEMBER 10th

Human Rights Day is observed every year on 10 December – the day on which the United Nations General Assembly adopted, in 1948, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The Universal Declaration of Human Rights empowers us all.

Human Rights Day (HRD) is <u>celebrated</u> annually around the world on 10 December every year.

The date was chosen to honor the <u>United Nations General Assembly</u>'s adoption and proclamation, on 10 December 1948, of the <u>Universal Declaration of Human Rights</u> (UDHR), the first global enunciation of <u>human rights</u> and one of the first major achievements of the new <u>United Nations</u>.

The day is normally marked both by high-level political conferences and meetings and by cultural events and exhibitions dealing with human rights issues. Besides, it is traditionally on 10 December that the five-yearly <u>United Nations Prize in the Field of Human Rights</u> and <u>Nobel Peace Prize</u> are awarded. Many <u>governmental</u> and <u>non-governmental organizations</u> active in the human rights field also schedule special events to commemorate the day, as do many civil and social-cause organizations

NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY

NOVEMBER 11

National Education Day is an annual observance in <u>India</u> to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana <u>Abul Kalam Azad</u>, the first <u>education minister</u> of independent <u>India</u>, who served from 15 August 1947 until 2 February 1958. National Education Day of India is celebrated on <u>11 November</u> every year

The Ministry of Human Resource Development announced on 11 September 2008, "The Ministry has decided to commemorate the birthday of this great son of India by recalling his contribution to the cause of education in India. November 11 every year, from 2008 onwards, will be celebrated as the National Education Day, with declaring it as a holiday." All educational institutions in the country mark the day with seminars, symposia, essay-writing, elocution competitions, workshops and rallies with banner cards and slogans on the importance of literacy and the nation's commitment to all aspects of education.

The day is also seen as an occasion to remember Azad's contribution in laying the foundations of the education system in an independent India, and evaluating and improving the country's current performance in the field



WORLD DAY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE

February 20th

World Day of Social Justice (Social Justice Equality Day) is an <u>international day</u> recognizing the need to promote <u>social justice</u>, which includes efforts to tackle issues such as <u>poverty</u>, <u>exclusion</u>, <u>gender inequality</u>, <u>unemployment</u>, <u>human rights</u>, and <u>social protections</u>.^{III} Many organizations, including the UN, <u>American Library Association</u> (ALA), and the <u>International Labour Organization</u>, make statements on the importance of social and present plans for greater social justice by tackling poverty, social and economic exclusion and unemployment. The <u>United Nations General Assembly</u> has decided to observe 20 February annually, approved on 26 November 2007 and starting in 2009, as the World Day of Social Justice.

The Declaration focuses on guaranteeing fair outcomes for all through employment, social protection, <u>social</u> <u>dialogue</u>, and fundamental principles and <u>rights</u>.

World Social Justice Day is celebrated on February 20th every year. The main objective of celebrating World Social Justice Day is to raise a voice against social injustice and to bring the various communities internationally together.



VOTER ENROLMENT DRIVE

Election commission of India offers online voter registration for Indian citizens who have attained the age of 18 on the qualifying date 1 Jan, 1 April, 1 July and 1 Oct of the year of revision of electoral roll). Citizens can enroll himself/herself as General Voter and fill Form 6 online at National Voters' Service Portal. Registered voters should also check their enrollment status.
