As a part of departmental activity, we celebrated Republic Day on 26-Jan-2018. On the occasion of Republic day we conducted the different cultural Sports activities.

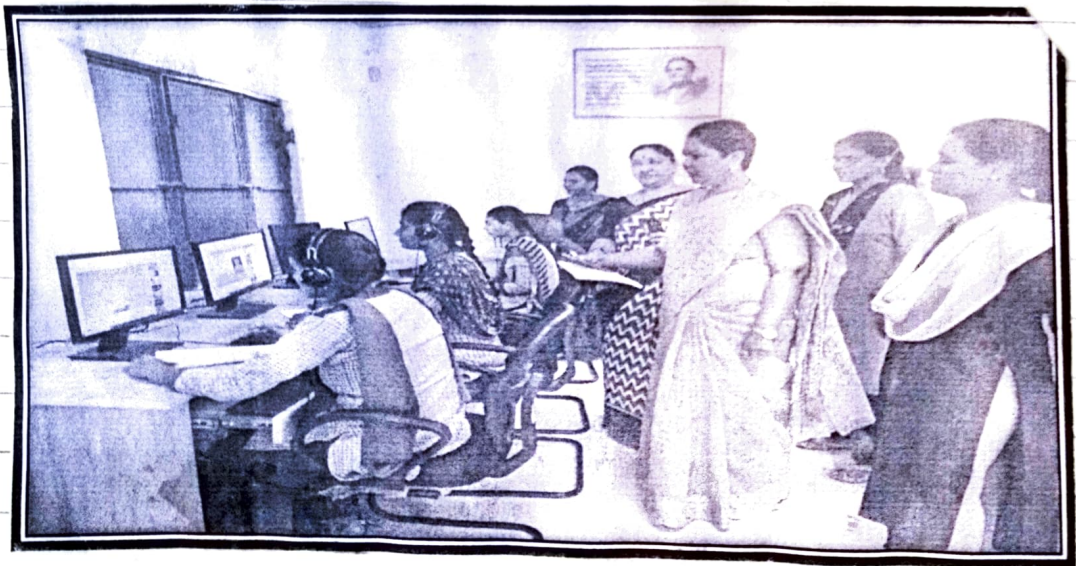
