The National Service Scheme (NSS) had its birth on September 24, 1969, during the Gandhi centenary year. The scheme was first launched in 37 universities.

Today the NSS has become the largest Government organization of students in the country comprising members from the Intermediate level to the university levels. The volunteers take part in various community service programs. The strength of NSS volunteers makes the NSS one of the largest student forces in the world.
