



Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into as of 11-08-2022 by and between:

- Government Degree College Medak, Department of Mathematics (GDCM-Maths), located at Medak, Telangana, India,
- Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential Degree College For Women (TTWRDC (W)) Medak, Department of Mathematics (TTWRDC(W)-Maths), located at [Address], Medak, Telangana, India,
- WHEREAS, GDCM-Maths and TTWRDC(W)-Math share a common interest in promoting the advancement of knowledge and education in the field of mathematics;

WHEREAS, GDCM-Maths has expertise and resources in mathematics education; and

WHEREAS, TTWRDC (W)-Maths is committed to providing its students with access to the latest developments and advancements in the field;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a framework for collaboration between GDCM-Maths and TTWRDC (W)-Maths in the following areas:

- Sharing the latest developments in the field of mathematics.
- Organizing guest lectures and extension lectures by faculty from both institutions.
- Conducting joint workshops, training programs, and seminars related to mathematics.
- Encouraging collaborative research projects between faculty members.
- Facilitating student exchange programs for participation in workshops and seminars.

2. Responsibilities

- GDCM-Maths agrees to:
 - Provide information on recent advancements in mathematics through guest lectures or workshops.
 - Collaborate in the development and organization of joint workshops, training programs, and seminars on mutually agreed-upon topics.
 - Explore the possibility of faculty exchange programs for guest lectures.

- Facilitate participation of its students in workshops, training programs, and seminars organized by GDCM-Math.
- Identify areas of interest for collaborative research projects and facilitate communication between faculty members.
- Explore possibilities for hosting guest lectures or workshops by faculty from GDCM-Math.

3. Coordination and Communication

A joint committee consisting of two representatives from each institution will be formed to coordinate activities under this MOU. The committee will meet periodically to discuss and plan collaborative programs.

4. Term and Termination

This MOU will be effective for a period of 3 years from the date of signing. It may be renewed by mutual written consent of both parties. This MOU may be terminated by either party upon 30 days' written notice to the other party.

5. Entire Agreement

This MOU constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous communications, representations, or agreements, whether oral or written.

6. Governing Law

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India.
