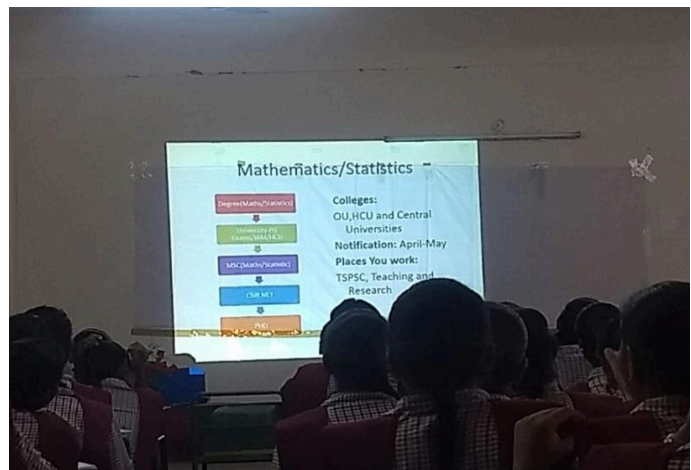


Career Guidance
