## **ANTI-RAGGING CELL POLICYDOCUMENT**

Telangana tribal welfare residential degree college of life science for women, Nizamabad is committed to providing a safe and healthy learning environment for students. The Anti-Ragging Cell is one of the important parts of the Educational Institution's mechanism. As per the guidelines of UGC under the Act of 1956, which is modified as UGC regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in higher Educational Institutions.

Ragging is strictly banned in our College. If any student or other is found to indulge in any ragging activities, strict action will be taken by the authorities. Ragging is banned by the Supreme Court of India. The primary objective of the ARC is to make sure that students maintain discipline in the college campus.

Members of the committee regularly go on rounds to class rooms and observe the behaviour of students. Being a WOMEN'S college, eve teasing is not our concern. However, the committee takes severe disciplinary action against students for any other ragging episodes.

There is a Suggestion Box placed in the college which students can use to make complaints if any. Alternately, students are free to approach committee members or any teacher they are comfortable with. Students should not make complaints unless it is serious as strict action will be taken. Thus, this cannot be used for mischief.

### **Objectives of Anti-Ragging Committee**

To ensure a safe and student friendly campus conducive for learning • To bring awareness in the students of the dehumanizing effects of ragging inherent in its perversity.

- To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.
- To promptly and stringently deal with the incidents of ragging brought to our notice. • To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.

**Function of Anti-Ragging Committee** As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- Any act of indiscipline, teasing or handling with rudeness.
- Any act that prevents or disrupts the regular academic activity.
- Any activity which is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, psychological harm or creates fear or apprehension.
- Any act of physical abuse causing assault, harm or danger to health. • Any act of abuse by spoken words, public insult etc.
- Any act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity. Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging

## **Punishments at the Institution Level**

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments

1. Debarring from appearing in Internal Exam / University Examination
2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
3. Withdrawing Admission and other benefits
4. Suspension from the college
5. Cancellation of the admission
6. Withholding the results.
